Double glazed window to the rear aspect. Low level WC, walk in shower cubicle. Vanity wash basin. Ceiling light and radiator.

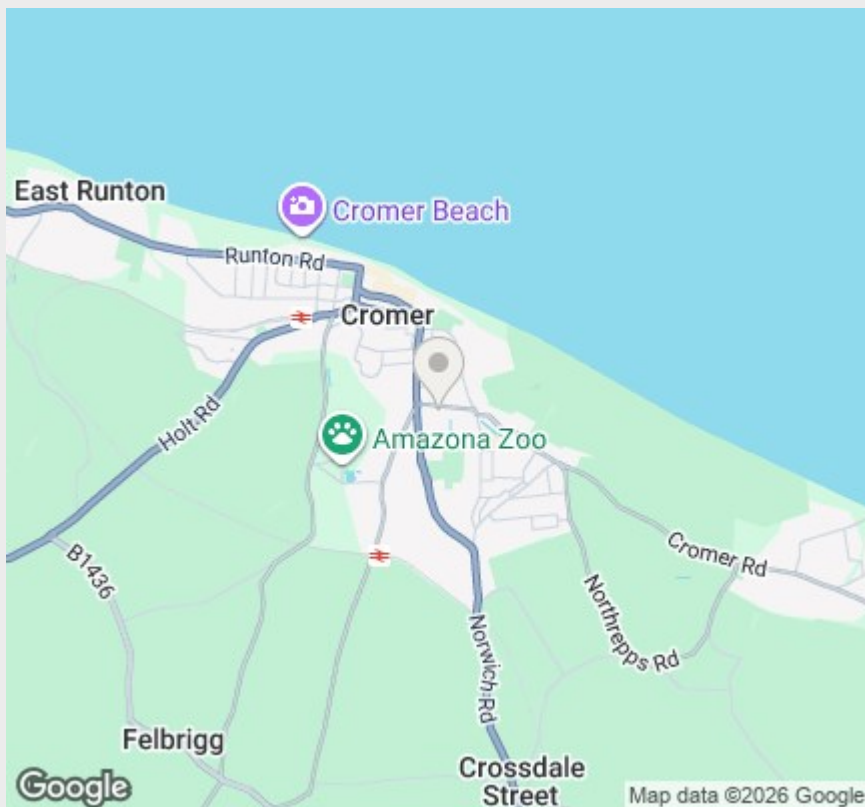
OUTSIDE

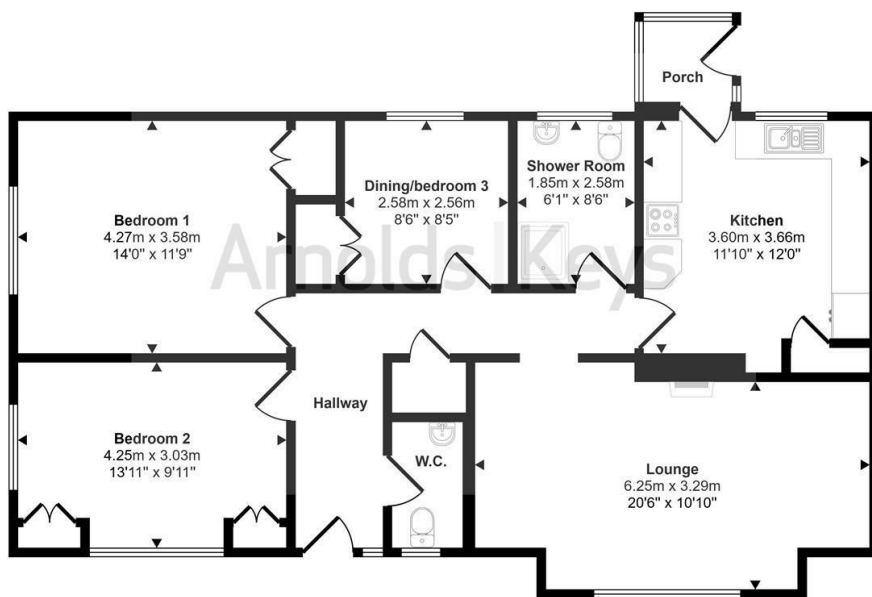
