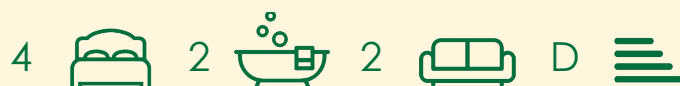

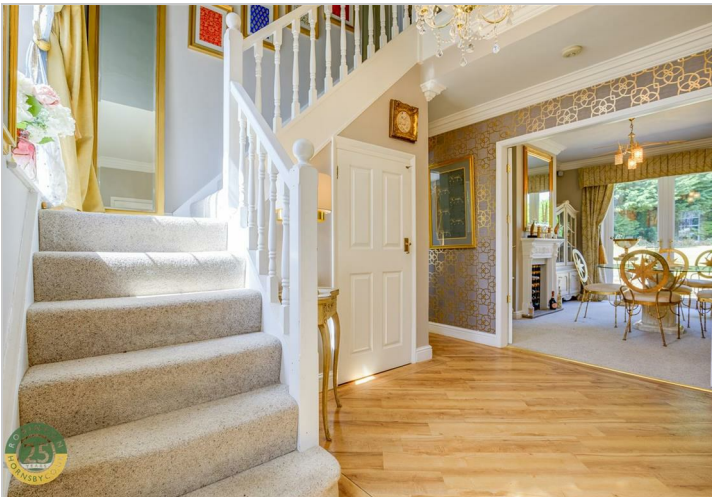
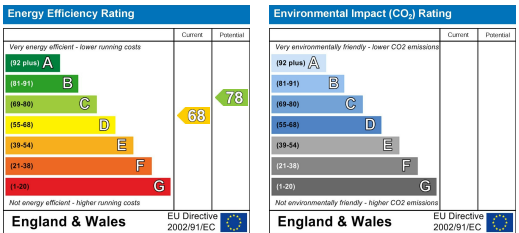
Floor Plan
